

Japanese knotweed: a guide for homeowners

If you discover Japanese knotweed – don't panic. There's a lot you can do to stop it becoming an issue



Remember, it is not illegal to have it on your land

The JPA strategy



- 1 Identification and confirmationit's not always knotweed
- 2 Preparation and implementation of site-specific management plan to include herbicide application programme
- **3** Final confirmation detailing what we have done and further steps required

Herbicide application options:

1 Spraying 2 Stem injecting

Should ideally be done when the plant is at its optimum growth
